

How to Build It (The Two Best Ways) Pool Noodle Car wash

1. The Garden Hose Hack (Easiest)

You can make a mini car wash in minutes with just a few basic supplies: [1]

What you need: 1-2 pool noodles, tape, a wooden pencil or skewer, and a garden hose.

Setup: Poke a row of small holes along one side of the pool noodle using your pencil. Tape or plug one end of the noodle shut, and attach the other end securely to your garden hose. Turn on the hose to create a fun, overhead sprinkler!

Pro tip: Thread the noodle through the handles of two water buckets to keep it balanced and elevated. [1, 2]

Level Up the Fun

Make playtime even more interactive by adding:

Sponges & Wash Mitts: Add a bucket of water mixed with tear-free baby soap and a few big, fluffy Chemical Guys Big Noodle Wash Mitt alternatives so kids can scrub their vehicles. [1, 2]
